We are sending you some other bids and appraisals of fossil skeletons in order to give you some idea of what some other projects, similar to this, cost.

Regarding the Quimby Mastodon, there was <sup>an</sup> additional competing bid from a major fossil company whose bid to restore, mold and mount the mastodon was \$250,000. Of course, none of these included any excavation. Generally speaking other dinosaurs similar to your allosaurus are valued at \$250,000 for a common hadrosaur, \$300,000 to \$500,000 for Triceratops and from \$500,000 to several million for rarer animals and T-rexs.

As you can see we are able to produce these same services more economically than most companies. This is, of course, possible because we have part ownership of the bones.
