Details of Project

(These reflect the order and list of things that have to be done. It is difficult to predict exact hours and costs, but this list gives a good, reasonable and flexible guide for the whole project. The end cost will be the same.)

1. 1 man day per bone = x 200 bones x 4 staff = 50 days
List:
2. Each jacket - dirt removed 2 men 1 day ea. jacket
3. Jacket turn over plaster new flat base on ea. 2 hr. ea.
4. Mold ea. jacket bones in situ 1 man day ea.
5. Partial prep. top side mold 2 man days on jacket
6. Gird map ea. bone in situ
