The excavation:

EXCAVATIONS:

We would agree up to be a longer period of "partnership" would be each skeleton as far as arrangement of the digs

5-yr period - this can always be everyone's best interest to do so. The work done on the site would be decided with each part: Landowner, Excavation, and Financial Backing.

Landowner: The landowner would be paid 10% of the gross sale of the bones. Asking price for the bones would be based on their appraised value. We could always agree to sell it for less if we wanted to, but we would need to be in agreement.

Excavator: The excavation and restoration fees would need to be discussed with the DeRosas and Joe. They need to be happy with expenses and percentages. They will need to give us a breakdown. What the excavators will be paid will be based on this.

We would like to be part of the excavation team at some point. If Joe and the DeRosas are in agreement to this then we would operate out of the following understanding. Before each skeleton is begun, we would need to know if we are still operating in a landowner capacity, or if at that point we are trained enough to receive excavator wages and/or percentages. Based on that decision, we (the Forbes) would decide to what extent that we could help with the excavation/restoration work. We hope that we could be trained with the DeRosas and Joe. If they agree to this, then we would need to know what would seem equitable and fair for that training. We hope that when we are helping on items from our own site that our labor would be sufficient, if not we are open to hearing what they think is a fair exchange for their time and knowledge.
