AFFIDAVIT

I Linda C. DeRosa, hereby state the following under the penalties of perjury.

1. My name is Linda C. DeRosa and I reside at 8614 W. Varricchio Ln. Crystal River, Fl.
and
2. I, Linda C. DeRosa first met Ms. Angela Hudson in May of 2001 in Colorado. We jointly attended a dinosaur dig. We quickly developed a "believed" friendship and offered her to visit us if she should ever come to Florida.
3. In late July, we received a call from Ms. Hudson saying that she was on her way to Florida. She arrived in her Hummer on 7-29-01 with her two sons Cy, and Levi, along with her dog.
4. Ms. Hudson came out to our house on 8-1-01. While there, she wrote a check to Creation Expeditions; this was a surprise as, it was unsolicited. My husband told her that we where not a "tax exempt" organization and could not give her a tax credit. She told us, that it was okay; she still wanted to help us. This check was for the sum of \$6000.00.
5. While in Crystal River, at Ms. Hudson's request, my husband made the arrangements for her sons, along with our daughter, to take scuba dive lessons. The lessons began in our home pool, then to Crystal River and finished at the Rainbow River. The children received their license on 8-1-01 in our home in Crystal River, Florida. The instructor for the dive lessons was David W. Mittelstadt. My husband had paid for all three of the kids' classes. Ms. Hudson reimbursed my husband later with a check.
6. While visiting in Florida, we where keeping Ms Hudson's dog for her. The dog chewed through the floor of our family room. We purchased replacement flooring from Home Depot. Ms Hudson wrote us a reimbursement check for \$1000.00.
7. Upon leaving Florida, Ms Hudson left her Hummer in Orlando. She, had been told that we would be going to a conference in Kentucky. From her home in Indiana she called to ask if we could drive her hummer back up to her. We agreed and my husband and son went to Orlando to pick it up. He paid the service man for detailing it and signed to release the Hummer. Upon returning the Hummer to Ms. Hudson, she reimbursed my husband with a check for the expenses incurred for this favor. This check was for \$1000.00
8. Ms. Hudson again came to our home on 1-25-02 to swim with the manatees. She and her sons stayed in our home. She again gave us a check to cover the expenses of her visit.
9. The last visit that we received by Ms. Hudson was in March of 2002. We were invited to be the guests of Ms. Hudson and her family at Disney World. While there, in Orlando, we all went to purchase

dive- equipment for her sons from Diver Outlet. Ms. Hudson's credit card account would not release the funds needed for the full purchase. Ms. Hudson asked my husband if he would pick-up the remaining balance on our account (which he did) and she would pay him back. The equipment purchased that day was the same that we delivered (as a friendly favor) to her in mid November 2003; after storing the bulky gear in our garage for over 7 months we as well as she wanted it to be back in her responsibility. Several times Ms. Hudson asked us to take on the responsibility of returning the equipment to her. My husband encouraged her to make her own arrangements but, that was never followed through with. We decided that since we would be passing through Indiana, and would like to have back for our use our limited garage space, we could divert from our route, and take the equipment to her.

10. On, October 11, 2002, Ms. Hudson came to San Antoino. She and her sons came to see the primer of "The Raising of the Allosaur" which played on the evening of the 12th. After a day together seeing the Imax of the Alamo, touring the Alamo, having lunch together with Mark Meadows on the Riverwalk we shared the "Raising the Allosaur" primer. There, Ms Hudson publicly proclaimed her support of our ministry (Creation Expeditions Inc.) and stated, most favorably, her personal character evaluation of the DeRosa family. On, the 13th of October 2002, I was witness to, Ms. Hudson writing a check to Creation Expeditions Inc. for the amount of \$6,000.00 while she awaited her taxi on the front porch of the Phillips home in San Antonio, Texas.
